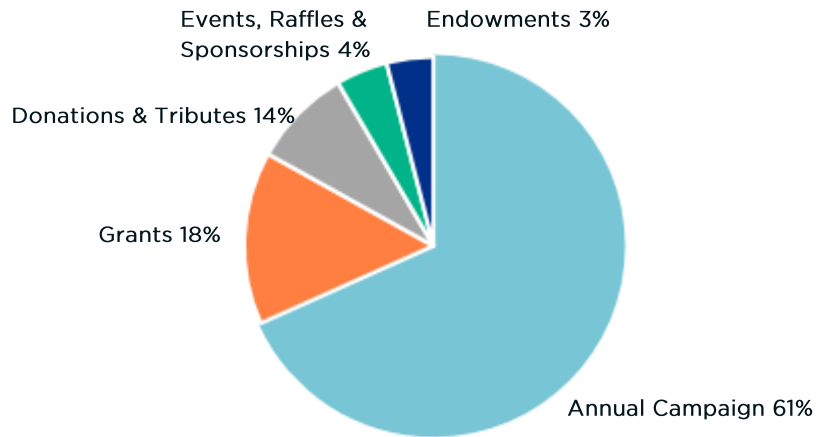

BUILDING FOR GOOD

The word has gotten out! We have broken ground. And we are well underway for building more good for our local community!

To date, we have raised \$8.4 million of our \$10.5 million goal. This will allow us to build the facilities we need to sustain growing programs, launch new services, and pay off all remaining debt from the original build of the Levin JCC and Early Childhood Pavilion.

Once this project is complete, we will have:

- New Senior Day Center, with a designated entrance
- Expanded Early Childhood Learning Center
- New outdoor amphitheater, gardens, and other green spaces around facilities
- Enhanced sound & lighting in Schechter Community Hall
- Dedicated sensory space
- And more parking!

Timeline:

- Fall 2023
Continue to raise funds & construction underway
- Fall 2024
Open the doors to new facilities

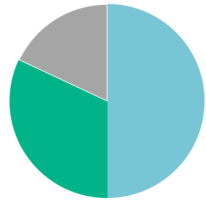

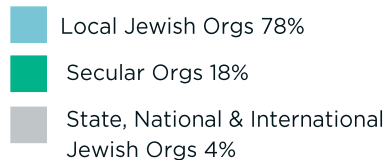
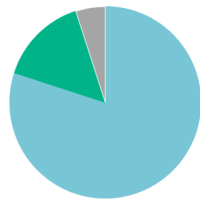

In 2017, the Jewish Community Foundation of Durham-Chapel Hill was selected to participate in the Harold Grinspoon Foundation LIFE & LEGACY Program. This program assists communities across North America to promote after-lifetime giving to benefit Jewish community organizations for generations to come. Through training, support, and monetary incentives, LIFE & LEGACY motivates Jewish organizations to secure legacy gifts, steward donors, and integrate legacy giving into the philanthropic culture of the Jewish community.

As we complete year six, our local partners have worked **together to secure over 300 legacy commitments**, of which 80% are legally formalized, **with an estimated value of over \$6.1 million**, to strengthen our local Jewish community.

Brought the **Ignite Series back in person**, and utilized local businesses as our venue to buy local!

Hosted **17th Annual Mitzvah Day**, providing 25 different ways for the community to do good.

Infused the arts into everyone's lives through art therapy, art classes, art lectures, and a unique Israeli Artist in Residence program.

Expanded our recreation programs to include Group Ex in the Park, a monthly exercise class held at Durham Central Park.
